Approval of Memorial school using Kiwanis on June 17th for annual field day

Bonnie Discussed the prices for a ropes course to be put at Kiwanis for Kids @ Play. Prices for a permanent course range from 17-23 grand. The process to obtain a permanent course can take 6-8 months beginning with an initial visit to determine where ropes course would be built. Bonnie explained another option of a portable course with the cost of \$3000 to be used this summer that was approved to purchase. Future determination of a permanent course will be looked at in the future.

Kids @ Play update was that all hires had been sent offer letters and paperwork has started to be turned in. Orientations will take place in May and June.

Swim Lesson costs for 2016 will change from \$60.00 for one child to \$80.00 for one child with a \$180.00 max per family for in town residents and \$90.00 for one child and \$190.00 for a max per family for our of town residents. It was discussed that this is still a value as other surrounding areas charge much more and for shorter sessions.

For the start of the fall Adult Rec programs we will kick off a meeting with all instructors to keep an open communication, looking for additional instructors.
