All new rates are permissible under MGL Chapter 46 Acts of 2003, section 104. Section 104 states: The first paragraph of section 10A of chapter 148 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: A fee of \$25, unless otherwise set by the Board of Selectmen or Town Council, and in a city by the mayor, may be charged by the head of the Fire Department for any permit granted under authority of this section, and any such permit may be revoked for cause by him or by the marshal, but in no event shall any such fee be greater then \$50.”
