News from the Town Clerk's office

General Election (Presidential Election) will be held Tuesday, November 5

Polls will be open from 7:00 am until 8:00 pm at Nipmuc
Regional HS gymnasium.

In addition to voting in-person on election day, voters have the option
to vote by mail, vote in-person during the early voting period or vote by
absentee ballot.

Vote By Mail: If you have already submitted a 2024 application to re-
ceive your ballot by mail for the General Election, we will automati-
cally mail you a ballot. If you have not submitted an application to
receive your ballot by mail the deadline to submit is Tuesday, Octo-
ber 29, 2024.

In-Person Early Voting schedule at Town Hall: Saturday, Oct. 19,
9 am to 3 pm; Monday, Oct. 21 thru Friday, Oct. 25 during regular
Town Hall hours; Saturday Oct. 26, 9 am to 3 pm; then Monday,
Oct. 28 thru Friday, Nov. 1 during regular Town Hall hours.

Absentee Ballot: If you are going to be out of town or unavailable
on Election Day you may apply for an Absentee Ballot to have
the ballot mailed to you or you can complete the application in
the Clerk's office and vote at that time. Absentee voting is avail-
able up until 12:00 pm (noon) on Monday.

tration forms, Vote By Mail and Absentee Ballot applications can
also be found on the Town Clerk's page.

Also, a **Special Town Meeting** has been scheduled for Tuesday, No-
vember 12, 2024 - 7:00 pm at Nipmuc HS auditorium. A copy of the
warrant for the meeting will be available on the town website and
posted at locations around town once it has been finalized.

Influenza usually ramps up in New England starting early in December so prime time to receive the flu vaccine is in October and November. SOCIAL SERVICES UPDATE

Medicare Open Enrollment starts in October



If you have a Medicare Part D Prescription Drug or Medicare Advantage plan, your plan will mail you an Annual Notice of Change (ANOC) by the end of September, summarizing changes to your plan for 2025. Your costs (premiums, deductibles, and copays), covered medications, and provider networks may change from year-to-year. Make sure you read this important document to decide if your plan will continue to meet your needs. If you do not receive it in the mail, call your plan to request another copy. You may request to change your 2025 plan during the annual Medicare Open Enrollment Period (Oct.15 - Dec. 7); these changes take effect January 1st.

SHINE counselors can help you to understand changes to your current plan & discuss other options. If you'd like to meet with our SHINE counselor at the Upton Community Center during open enrollment, please call the Upton Senior Center at 508-529-4558 to make an appointment.

SMOC Fuel Assistance

Fuel Assistance is available to income eligible households. The fuel assistance program runs from November 1st—April 30th. If you were approved for Fuel Assistance last year, you will be receiving a pre-printed re-application form within the next month directly from SMOC (South Middlesex Opportunity Council) for the upcoming heating season. To avoid delays in receiving your benefits, gather your updated documents early and review any changes that need to be made on your application. Our Social Services Coordinator, Katie San Clemente, can assist you.

Tax-Aide Program Needs Volunteers to Help Taxpayers

Central MA - Tax filing season may be months away, but our local team is already seeking volunteers who want to serve their community through the AARP Foundation's Tax-Aide program. Tax-Aide focuses on serving older adults living with low to moderate income and helps them secure much-needed tax refunds.

Volunteers are trained, and classes are generally held in December and January for the upcoming tax filing season.

The amount of training required depends on the position.

During tax filing season February through April, the volunteers will assist taxpayers while the local site is in operation.

During the tax season the time commitment is 4 or more hours per week.

About AARP Foundation Tax-Aide Program

MA residents can get their taxes done for free beginning in early February and continuing through mid-April. AARP Foundation Tax-Aide, the nation's largest free tax preparation assistance service, has low-contact, contact-free, and in-person options for providing taxpayer assistance. These options vary by location and are subject to change.
