- Upton’s Land Use regs refers to Mass Dept. of Fish and Wildlife regs which allows hunting within 500’ of a dwelling.
- Residents showed two maps – one with a 500’ circle (existing) and a second with a 1,000’ circle (proposed).
- Residents referred to website – Mass Council.
- Proposal for Glen Echo open space only.
- Mr. Howarth – would like to keep to the 500’; 1) Balance in the forest – deer population and 2) Tick problem becomes worse. Over population of deer will cause more of a tick problem and they will de-forest the area.
- Hunting season is for 1 -2 months (Oct/Nov).
- Hunters use shot guns (not riffles) to hunt deer.
- Mr. Howarth asks hunters to come in. Fish and Wildlife personnel.
- Hunters have to have permits, training and special equipment.
- 1,000 feet would eliminate the open space land for hunting; 3 lots.
- Conservation Commission Act – UCC has complete control over land use regulations in the town.
- Homeowners should come up with wordings for the proposed land regs changes.
- UCC will look into posting requirements
