



## PROCEEDINGS OF ANNUAL TOWN ELECTION

May 6, 2025

Seema Kenney, Warden, declared the polls open at 7:00 am at Nipmuc Regional High School. Megan Ronzio was the Precinct Clerk for precinct one (P1), Lauren Montenegro Precinct Clerk for precinct two (P2) and Lynn Gruber Precinct Clerk for precinct 3 (P3).

At 8:00 pm the Warden declared the polls closed. All mail ballots received at town hall by 8:00 pm were delivered to the polls for processing. Upon processing these ballots the tabulators were closed out and results of the election were printed from each of the three DS200 tabulation machines. There were 739 votes cast (including three hand-counted ballot). Precinct one – 262; Precinct two – 246; and Precinct three - 231.



The total number of ballots voted was **739** out of 6,648 registered voters (including 164 inactive) representing an **11%** turnout. This included 704 in person (95%) and 35 mail (early/absentee) ballots (5%). The unofficial results of the election were read at 8:30 pm.
